**Pupil Support includes:** librarians, counselors, and nurses

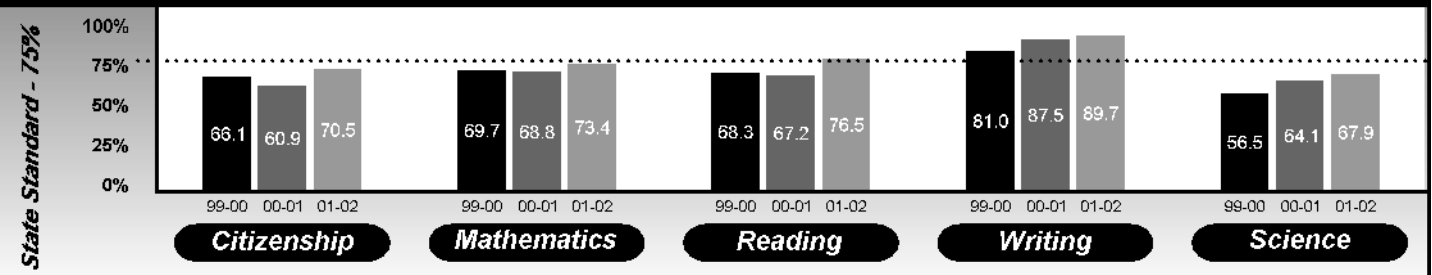
**Staff Support includes:** teacher training and college courses

**Private Funds includes:** foundation grants and corporate donations

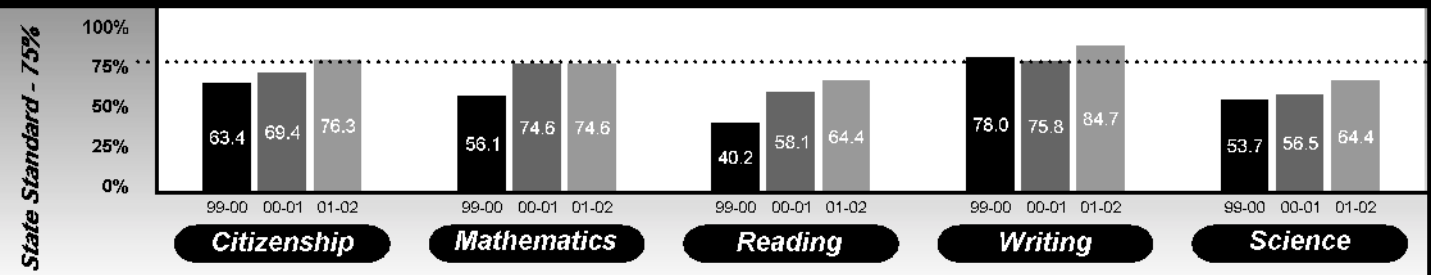

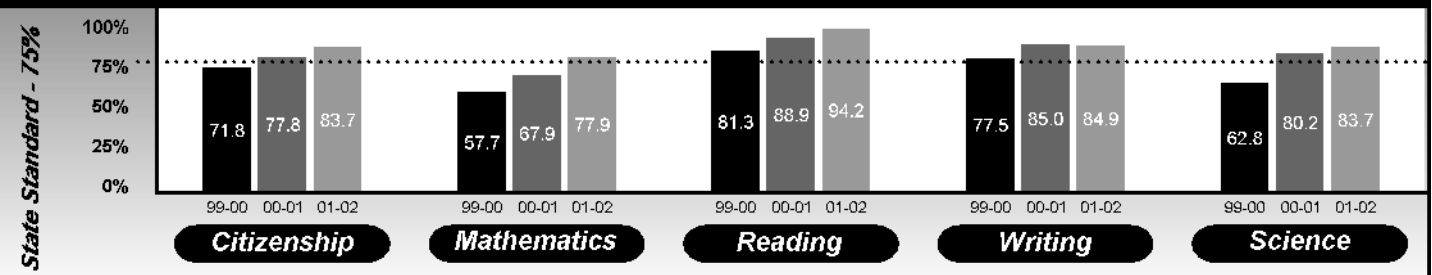
### 4TH GRADE PROFICIENCY



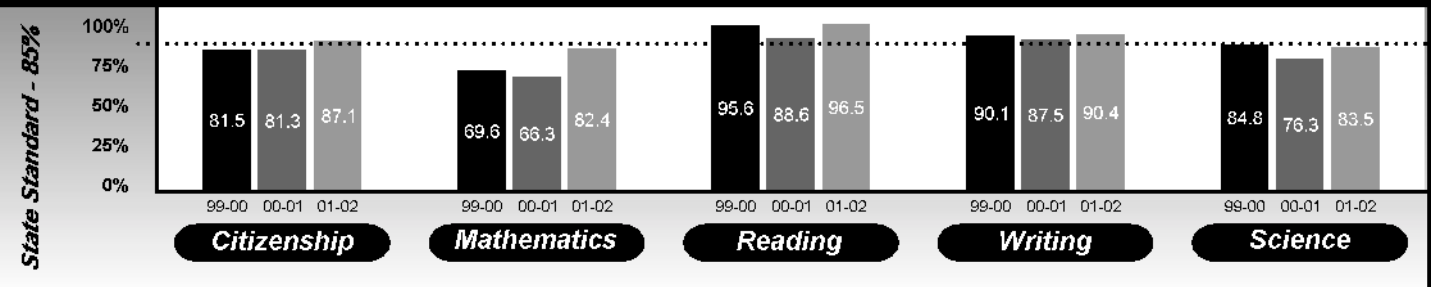
### 6TH GRADE PROFICIENCY
